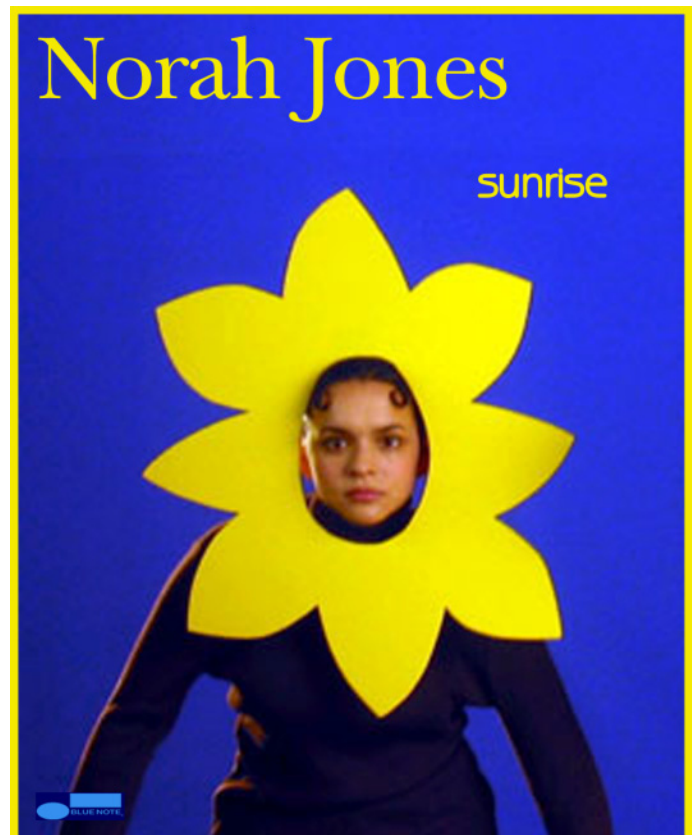

It looks like Michael Feinstein has an AC hit on his hands. "Only One Life" (Concord) last week's #1 "most added" picks up yet another group of believers in his second week. This is from his CD of songs from the brilliant and talented Jimmy Webb. Melissa Manchester also has another blockbuster week on her hands as her latest track, "After All This Time" (Koch) appears to be off and running with no trouble what so ever.

Newcomer Paul Geng adds another week of "most added" action to his long list. "Don't Take Kindness for Weakness" (Bad Penny) is "off like a rocket" and the early word from radio has been very positive. Vincent James is set to break into the top 5 of the main chart in the coming weeks. "One More Night" (Dipop) has been on a steady march almost each week since it has been out and don't be surprised if it actually finds a place at the very top of our AC40 chart.

Swedish quintet The Sounds, return to US soil for a 30 + date winter tour, as main supporting act for New York's The Strokes. Prior to joining The Strokes, The Sounds, will be headlining their own tour in support of their Scratchie/New Line release "Living In America". The "Living In America Tour" will begin February 15th

in Milwaukee, WI, with Kill Hannah and IMA Robot supporting through March 6th. On March 9th The Sounds join The Strokes in Washington, DC for a month. Starting April 3rd The Sounds will resume their headlining tour in San Francisco, guaranteeing this to be far and away one of the hottest tours of 2004 and www.456entertainment.com will be posting updated tour dates daily.

Hootie and the Blowfish have a new one out this week. "Goodbye Girl" (Atlantic) is the track and could put the boys back on track. "She Says" (Epic) by Howie Day is "going for adds" next week and that has a good shot to do some damage out there in the AC40 world. "Time After Time" (J) by Rod Stewart also hits the AC streets and it continues his string of standard releases. Many of the tracks from his reach back in time have not really given him much radio chart activity but they are selling none the less. Many of you out there at AC radio may have received your nomination ballots for this years 1st Annual NMW Awards. Be sure to take some time this week to fill them out and either fax or email them back. Don't be shy about nominating your station or programming team in the appropriate categories. We will be making ongoing announcements in the up coming weeks about this special event.
