Alanis Morissette is back once again and this time with a ballad. "Everything" (Maverick/Reprise)

is the track and you can be sure that many of our AC's, especially the ones that run Hot will be closing this out in record time. "I'm Ready" by Cherie (Lava) is starting to get a buzz out there in AC land. This new artist has what it takes to win this format over, so give it a shot and you won't be disappointed. "Don't Tell Me" (Arista) by Avril Lavigne is also making some good noise out there as well this week.

Dana Mase is having another blockbuster week at radio. "Tearstreaks" (Water) is the single that ranked #1 "most added" at the format last week and continues strong once again. Live w/Shelby Lynn is getting some raves out there at AC radio. Burke Roney is having another powerful week with his latest offering "Sounds Of The Ocean" (Sin-Drone Records) and it's another strong week at radio for Renee Sebastian and her "Deliciously Dangerous" (RSR) that makes a strong AC40 debut this week.

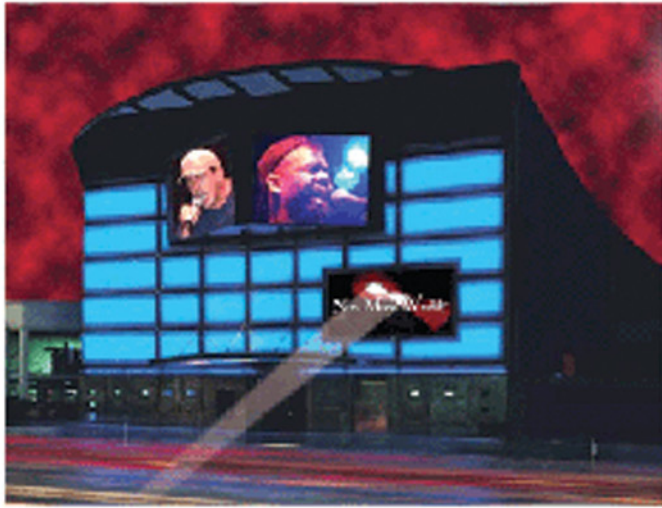
